



Arkansas Rural Health Partnership Student Medical Internships for High School Seniors Guidelines

Arkansas Rural Health Partnership and University of Arkansas for Medical Science has partnered with your local hospital to provide an opportunity for students to gain real-world experience within the medical field during the Summer of 2021. We understand that getting hands-on experience as a high school student can be difficult. This program will offer high school incoming and graduating seniors with a paid opportunity to work in your local hospital and gain insight into a future career in healthcare.

Guidelines for Student Applicants:

- Applicants selected for this program must be an incoming high school senior with a serious interest in working in the healthcare field or be a declared incoming college student majoring in a healthcare related field of study. Some exceptions may apply but will need to be approved by the ARHP CEO.
- Applicants must currently reside in the counties of Arkansas, Ashley, Bradley, Chicot, Columbia, Dallas, Desha, Drew, Jefferson, Ouachita, Phillips, and Union counties.
- Applicants must submit a completed application along with a Letter(s) of Recommendation by April 30th. (See guidelines on application).
- Students must be in good academic standing and have maintained a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Students will be required to participate in a mandatory orientation, Mental Health First Aid training, weekly trainings with ARHP and weekly scheduled internship calls with ARHP internship director.
- Student will have to submit a final report to Arkansas Rural Health Partnership staff prior to completion of their internship.



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
